

## ***THIRD-DAY HIGHLIGHTS***

Lemont raced out to a 16-6 first-quarter lead and never looked back in snapping a five-game losing streak at its own Classic with a 69-42 victory over Walther Lutheran. **Alex Nelson** was one of four Lemont players to put those losses in the past – all of which came in either overtime or by two points – by scoring in double figures. He registered a double-double (19 points, 10 rebounds) and helped the Indians shoot 54 percent from the field and outrebound the Broncos, 43-27. Walther, which converted at just a 31.8 percent clip, was led by **Logan Davis**' 11 points ... The original top seed in the large school division, Stagg needed a three-pointer by **Niko Sheinfeld** (13 points, 8 rebounds) at the buzzer to avoid going 0-3 in the tournament as the Chargers defeated Argo, 42-41. The Argonauts' **Godfrey Brown** led all scorers with 17 points ... Romeoville pulled away from Lisle in the fourth quarter to claim the small school consolation championship with a 58-48 win. **Donte Fuller** provided 16 points and 7 rebounds to the winning cause with **Kordel Smith** chipping in another 13 points. Lisle, which did itself in with 27 turnovers, received a game-high 23 points from **Marcus Wilson** ... It wasn't pretty, but Carl Sandburg gained the large school consolation title with a 34-28 win over Reavis, which shot just 20.9 percent for the game (9-of-43). The Eagles were just slightly better at 33.3 percent (11-of-33). Sandburg's **Vince Kmiec** was the only player to score in double figures and he made it at the minimum mark, 10 points ... Leyden outlasted Downers Grove North, 56-54, thanks to five players scoring no less than 7 points and the Eagles shooting 62.5 percent after the break (10-of-16). Highlighting the balanced attack was **Brandon Stinson** (13 points) and **Mike Woolf** (12 points, 7 rebounds). **D.J. Cienawa** totaled 17 points and 6 boards for the Trojans ... Falling behind 10-7 after one quarter, Westmont outscored Evergreen Park 34-13 over the next two frames to erase an earlier loss to the Mustangs with a 53-34 victory. **Jacob Lechelt** led the Sentinels with 18 points. Evergreen Park's lone double-figure scorer was **Darrius Richardson** (10 points) ... Hinsdale South outscored Plainfield Central 25-13 in the fourth quarter to pull away from the defending champions, while advancing to the title game itself for the second time in three years with a 53-44 win. **Joe Petrak** (16 points) and **Lavonte Brown** (12) were two big reasons. Plainfield Central's **Winston Williams** just missed a double-double with his 14 points and 9 rebounds ... Like Hinsdale South, Joliet Catholic also put up 25 points in the fourth quarter to distance itself from Chicago Christian, winning 73-63 to advance to its first-ever Classic title-game appearance. The Hilltoppers hit 7-of-9 shots from the field in the decisive quarter with leading scorer **Breshion Tucker** (29 points) also nailing 8-of-9 free throws. **Wes Koral** provided another 19 points, including a monstrous dunk in the fourth. **Adam Lindemulder** paced the Knights with 17 points and 6 boards.
