

FOURTH-DAY HIGHLIGHTS

Behind **Bilal Fokaha's** 18 points and 14 rebounds, Reavis captured tournament consolation third-place honors with a 57-36 victory over Lisle. **Ayhem Abdelkader** tacked on another 15 points for the Rams, while the Lions received 12 points and 7 boards from **Phil Palicka**. Reavis put things away in the second half holding Lisle to 23.8 percent shooting (5-of-21) and 31.3 percent for the game (15-of-48) ... **Darius Welch** nailed a short jumper with 1.5 seconds left and then the Mustangs held their collective breaths as a Downers Grove North three-pointer at the buzzer came up empty in Evergreen Park's 54-52 tournament seventh-place victory. **Cedric Watkins** and **T.J. Cobbs** put the Mustangs in position to win the game with 21 and 18 points, respectively, while **Welch** (9 points, 9 rebounds) just missed on a double-double. It did not hurt that Evergreen Park hit 13 of 18 shots from the field (72.2 percent) after the break, either, while Downers Grove North struggled at 31.7 percent for the game (19-of-60). Three Trojans scored in double figures topped by **D.J. Cienawa's** 16 points to go along with his 8 rebounds ... Leyden cruised to tournament fifth-place honors with a 68-52 win over Westmont as Eagle teammates **Mike Woolf** and **Brandon Stinson** put on a shooting display. **Woolf** nailed 7 treys on his way to a game-high 31 points with **Stinson** hitting 5 three-pointers en route to his 21-point performance. **Kevin Good** provided a team-high 16 points for Westmont ... Carl Sandburg averaged only 7 field goal attempts per quarter, but hit on 16 of them for the game (57.1 percent), including 7 of 8 in the second half, to get by Romeoville, 40-32, to pick up tournament consolation championship honors. **Vince Kmiec** (14 points) and **D.J. Bennett** (13 points), who went 6-for-6 from the field, did the majority of the Eagle damage, while **Bo Goshorn** (12 points) was the lone Spartan in double figures ... Trailing by as many as 15 points early in the third quarter, Plainfield Central outscored Chicago Christian 40-18 the rest of the way to win the tournament third-place game, 58-51. Plainfield's **Derrick Marks** took over the game after the break, where he scored 23 of his tournament-high 34 points. The Wildcats went from shooting 28.6 percent in the first half (8-of-28) to 60.9 percent in the closing 16 minutes (14-of-23), while Chicago Christian was nearly the exact opposite at 50 (10-of-20) and 28.6 percent (6-of-21). **Kevin Pittman, Jr.**, led the Knights with 14 points ... Hinsdale South claimed its second Classic crown in three years aided by tournament MVP **Lavonte Brown's** 22 points and 10 rebounds and another 17 markers from **Phil Brown**. The Hornets put things away early with a 19-6 second-quarter run. **Breshion Tucker** paced Joliet Catholic for the fourth straight game with his 18 points.
