Symptom Screening

Every Lemont High School student will be required to show proof of a completed mandatory symptom screening <u>each day</u> before entering the building or boarding a bus. This symptom screening must be completed by the student's parent/guardian <u>at midnight or after on the day of attendance.</u>

Lemont High School is utilizing the symptom screening tool made available through Skyward Family Access. Students and parents/guardians already are familiar with navigating Skyward Family Access, so completing this daily task should be convenient for both parents/guardians and students.

PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES

- <u>Download</u> the Skyward app to your phone or tablet.
- <u>Log in</u> with your Family Access credentials (if you have misplaced your credentials, visit the Family Access login screen that is available from the school's website, and click the "Forgot your Login/Password?" link).
- <u>Choose</u> "Today's Screening" under 'Wellness Screenings.' (see 1.) <u>Please note this</u> must be done at midnight or after on the day of attendance.
- Answer the questions and hit "Submit." (see 2.)
- Screenshot the daily verification and send to your student (see 3.)


STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

• <u>Show</u> your symptom screening verification to the campus supervisor or bus aide prior to entering the school or bus. This can be done from a screenshot sent to you by your parent/guardian, or by logging in to Skyward Student Access.


IMPORTANT NOTES


- Students whose parents/guardians do not complete the symptom screening will be required to report to a tent outside the Julia Street entrance to be screened on campus before entering the building, or will be screened by a bus aide before boarding a bus. This will delay the student being able to enter the school or board a bus.
- Students who do not have a phone, but whose parent/guardian completed the screening, can provide their five-digit "Other ID" to the campus supervisor to look up their status *upon arriving on campus*. This cannot be done to board the bus. The "Other ID" can be found under "Student Info" in Family Access.
- Parents/guardians <u>can</u> use the desktop version of Family Access to complete the screening questions. However, it is easier to send a screenshot of the completed screening to students from a phone or tablet. If a parent/guardian wishes to use the desktop version, students should download the Skyward app in order to most easily show proof of the completed screening.
