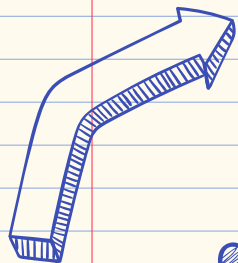
what comes next?

Choose wisely.

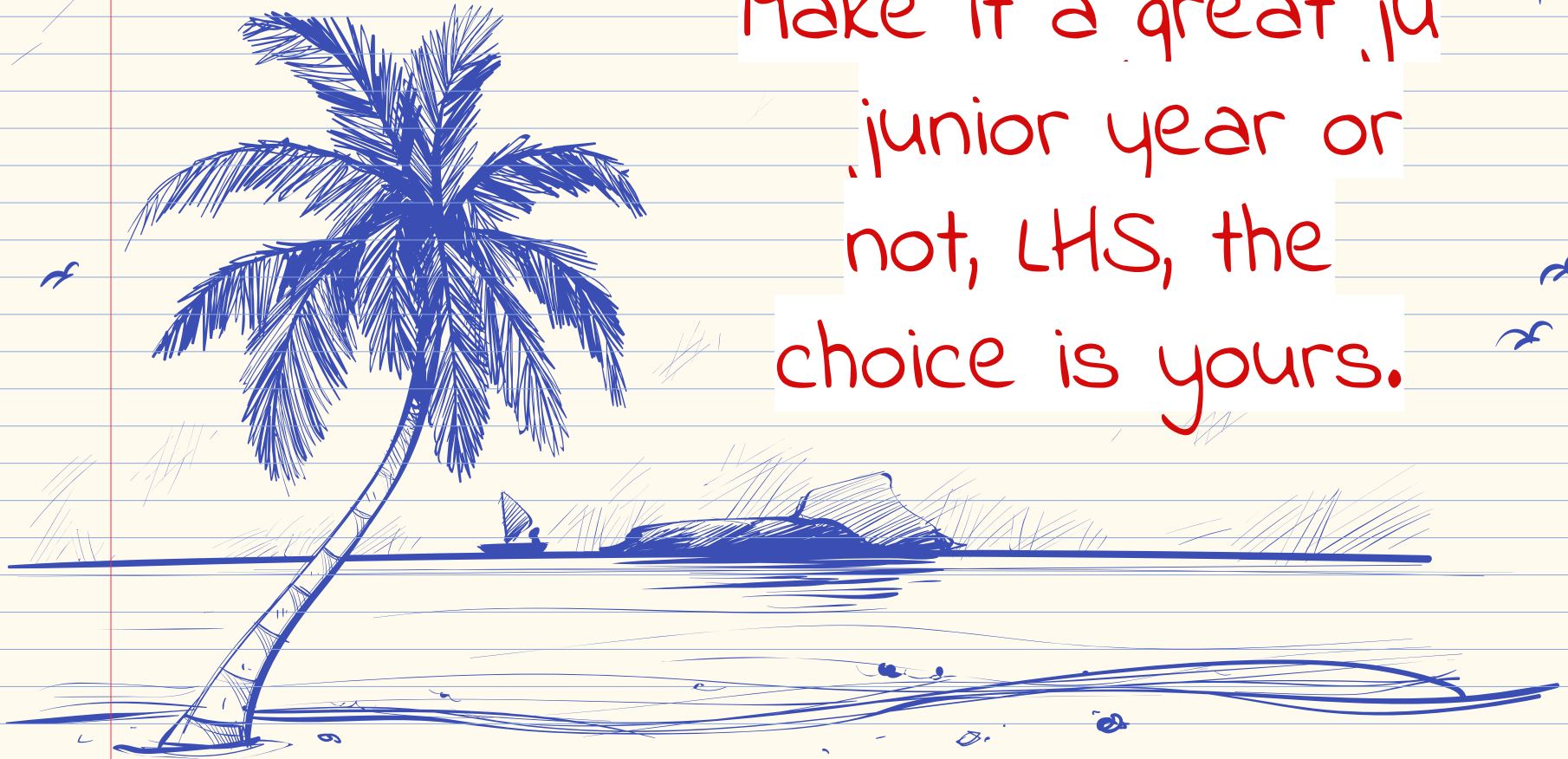
Adjustments will be made if you meet/exceed standards in the spring testing cycle.
